By the Bay Kids®, our pediatric care program, helps infants, children, and teens through the crisis of serious or life-limiting illness. We appreciate the unique needs of our young patients and care for them in a way that focuses on enhanced quality of life, by minimizing pain, fear, and uncertainty.

NEED PERSONALIZED CARE

We will work with you and your family physician to create a care plan, based on your personal values, that includes:

- Option to receive care at home, hospital, or care facility
- Helping you understand your child's illness and what to expect in the future
- An effective strategy for managing pain and symptoms
- Seamless coordination with your medical providers
- A safe and comfortable transition from hospital to home
 - Training for family and friends to provide care between visits

AND COMPREHENSIVE SUPPORT

We know there are multiple challenges in having a seriously ill child, so we extend our care to provide support to include the entire family. We will help connect you to community resources, provide emotional support, and offer special programs for siblings, who can sometimes feel left out of the

caregiving process.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Upon admission, each child is assigned a dedicated care team who will surround them with pediatric expertise, using a supportive, patient and family-centered approach.
